## Speaking ielts part 2 pdf

Part 2 tests your ability to talk about a topic, develop your ideas on a topic, and relevant vocabulary and grammar. The examiner will give you a 'task card' with written directions. The examiner will ask you to talk about the topics and include the points you can cover in your talk. The topic is about a personal experience. You'll be given one minute to prepare your talk, and you'll be given a pencil and paper to make notes (don't write on the task card) You should talk about the topic for one to two minutes. You can use your notes to help you. Then the examiner will ask you one or two questions on the same subject. Topic 1 Take one minute to prepare a talk on the following topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe a museum How do you often visit the museum? What type of museum is popular in your country? Why do you want to visit the museum? Follow-up: What do you think of the importance of museums in history? How do you think of the inheritance of a country? Compare the museums these days and in the past Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe your favorite photo Where is the photo taken? Who took the photo? What can be seen of the photo? Explain why this is the favorite photo for you. Follow-up: How to take good photo? When do people use camera? How can the new tech set theater's skill advanced? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe an area of your country you know and like Where is it? What are its special features? What do you and other people do in this area? Explain why you like it. Follow-up: What do you think of the historic place in the future? Will the government raise or reduce the security guard? What are the changes to the local people and economy? What is the impact on the historic place by tourists? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe a party What is the party? Why was the party held? Who attended the party? What did you do for that party? Follow-up: What's the difference between serious party and friendly party? Why are some people late for parties deliberate? Why do some people like partying while others hate it? What would you do if the guests felt bored? Will there be more and more people to attend parties? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember for reasons and include. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Talk about a subject you are studying Which subject are you studying? You? is the subject about? How do you feel about it? Explain why you're interested in it. Follow-up: Is there any difference between the traditional and modern educational systems? What are the pros and cons of the current educational system in your country? Do you think it's necessary to give comments or criticism to teachers? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. What is the important invention before the age of the computer? What is the invention? Why do you think it's very important? What are the advantages and disadvantages of the invention? Follow-up: What is the significant impact of modern inventions on life? What skills do you want to study in the future? Do you think it is necessary to develop modern invention in the countryside? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe an interesting city you know and like Where is it? How did you go there? What did you do there? Explain why you found it so interesting. Follow-up: Say something about the tourism development in your country, facility, services and the impact on environment. What is the importance of travel and tourism industry? What do you think is the function of tourist guides? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe your favorite movie What's the name of the film? What is the theme of the film? Why do you like it? Follow-up: Describes a type of pf movie you like. What's the difference between Chinese and American movies? What do you think of the violent films (Hollywood films)? Why do movies need computer techniques? Any example of film using computer techniques? Which parts of cinema are most important and how to improve it? What kind of books/newspapers/magazines do Chinese adolescents read? With the popularity of the internet, do you think newspapers and magazines will disappear? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Follow-up: What do you think of the benefits of children's games? These days, kids have less and less time for game, what do you think of that? How does Chinese celebrate some happy events? What does the camera and video play in the celebration? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe something you possess that is very important to you that gave you this? What is it? What does this mean for you? Follow-up: What are the changes of city between now and past? Does money represent happiness and why? How do you consider the things people want to earn? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe one of your neighbors When did you become neighbors? Do you meet often? Name whether your neighbor is a good one. Follow-up: What's the difference between neighbors and friends? Why do people love watching TV series in their homes? How do you think of the relationship in the city? How to improve the neighborhood? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe one of the shopping malls you often go to Where is the mall? How often do you go to the center? Why do you often go after that and its qualities? Follow-up: Will smaller stores survive in the current business system? What are the features of shopping malls and smaller stores and their difference? What is the trend of future malls? Talk about online shopping. Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe your favorite animal What kind of animal is this? Briefly describe it. Why do you like the animal? Follow-up: What should you do to take care of it? What is the future trend of the animal? How do you think of the poaching of a few precious animals like pandas? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to talk between one Two minutes. Describe a historical place What is the place? Where is it located? What is the historical significance of the place? Follow-up: What do you think of the future trend of historical places? Will the government strengthen its protection towards historic places? What are the changes brought about by the historical place in local economy, people, etc? What is the effect of tourists on the spot? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Ad What are the forms of ad? What are the features of ad? What is the effect of advertising for people? Follow-up: Do you feel bored and disgusted by ad? What do you think are the criteria for assessing a good piece of ad? What will happen if unauthorized ads prevail in the market? Take one minute to prepare a talk on the next topic. Take notes if you like and remember to include reasons and examples. You then have to speak for between one and two minutes. Describe an important letter When did you receive the letter? From whom did you receive the letter? Explain the reasons why this is important. Do you think the brand name is very important for sales? As for the media, what do you think will play a lead role in current giving, television, newspaper or internet? Describe your holiday Where do you go for the holidays and how long do they last? Who do you go with? Talk about any interesting things happening during your holidays. Follow-up: What do the Chinese people mostly do in their spare time? What's the difference between holidays today and 5 years ago and the reasons for the change? Do you think people will spend more time on leisure or work in the future? Part 2 The questions in Part 1 are on three known topic areas. The first topic will be Studies, Work or Where You Live. Your answers come from your life and experience. There is no right or wrong answer. Can you please show me your identification card? Can you please tell me your full name? What will I call you? Do name has any special meaning? Why are so many people changing their names? Is your name important to you? Where are you from? Where do you live?? Can you tell me something about your hometown? Can you tell me some famous landscapes or scenic spots in your hometown? Can you tell me a history of your hometown? Are you a student or do you have a job? What do you like most about your study? What kind of work do you prefer after graduation? What is your major? What do you do to live? Can you tell me a typical day from you? How do you get your job? Are you happy with your work?
